After several years of orthodontic treatment, Augustin now has a bright, healthy smile and is full of confidence. His mother, who was being treated for a serious illness, received dental care from another CADF volunteer and board member, Dr. Stanley LaCroix.

Cheyenne found her voice with the help of the CADF and its partnership with Goodwill Central Texas, which matches volunteer dentists with Goodwill trainees who have dental needs that are serving as a barrier to employment.

Since the CADF - Goodwill program began, CADF volunteers and dental labs have donated more than \$70,000 in care care to 21 patients.

Cheyenne was cared for by Dr. Lance Sanders, a longtime volunteer with CADF and a current member of the board.

“I used to not be able to get up and speak in front of people or even laugh. But now I can. Dr. Sanders did a lot for me,” Cheyenne said.

Since having her dental work, Cheyenne has gotten a raise and a promotion at work. “I have more respect for myself and I appreciate life more. I will always be thankful to the Capital Area Dental Foundation.”




Every \$1 donated to CADF equals \$3 in charitable dental care provided!

CADF has 108 volunteer dental providers across its 6 programs.


On any given day, about 3 HAAM patients are being cared for in a CADF volunteer's dental office.
